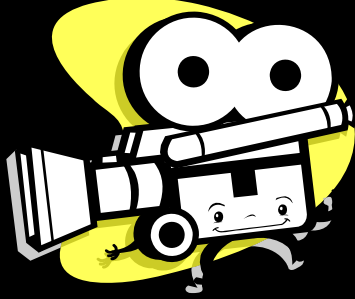

## **DIN LO JING JUEN 癡佬正传 • Hong Kong**

An exceptional and at times disturbing drama on mental health issues starring Chow Yun-Fat and Tony Leung Chiu Wai as the mentally ill. The somewhat fact-based tale centers on a social worker's attempts to help people with mental illness who live and work on the teeming city streets. This film has won 1987 Hong Kong Film Awards.

## **A VIEW FROM THE OTHER SIDE • Singapore**

The 15-minute clip centers on Derrick, a polytechnic student, who was unable to adjust to the changes in his family following the death of his father. He began to display the early signs of psychosis and, haunted by auditory hallucinations, slipped into his own world. Derrick started to recover and went back on track. The video encourages teenagers to seek help if they face similar problems like Derrick's or if they find it hard to cope with schoolwork and life.
